Dear Kane County Board of Election Officials,

As parents and constituents of St. Charles Community Unit School District 303, we ask that the officials of the Kane County Board of Election review the enclosed affidavit and recall petition of D303 School Board members: Nick Manheim, Carolyn Waibel, Jillian Barker, Edward McNally, Becky McCabe, and Mike Bryant. After filing the Recall Affidavit on January 8, 2021, Board Member Mike Bryant resigned from the school board on January 11, 2021. His name was subsequently removed from the circulated petition forms.

On January 8, 2021 an Affidavit of Intent to Circulate a Petition for the Recall of Certain District 303 Board Members was filed with the Kane County Recorder's office. The notarized affidavit was signed by ten (10) parents and taxpayers from the D303 community. The submitted recall affidavit included evidentiary support for all claims made by the undersigned. The parents and taxpayers are all residents residing in homes within Kane County and the State of Illinois and who have children attending school within this District, and are all U.S. citizens and registered voters.

Many D303 constituents need St. Charles District 303 school board members to make data driven decisions for all students and taxpayers and to hold Dr. Pearson accountable for academic results and student well-being. As elected officials they have not kept their Oath of Office to their constituents to provide an equitable, transparent, and quality education for every student in the School District. Prior to the Covid-19 pandemic District 303's academic performance had been in decline. Board members have not held Dr. Pearson accountable to improve academic results and reverse this decline. As a result, many District 303 constituents request that these five (5) board members be recalled or resign from their board positions effective immediately.

The undersigned parents and taxpayers individually and collectively affirm that he/she has personal knowledge of the facts stated in this recall affidavit (please see Exhibits A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H), and that he/she could personally testify to the same if called upon to do so. Under penalty of perjury, the undersigned parents and taxpayers, individually and collectively affirm that the facts stated in this affidavit are true and correct of their knowledge and belief.

Based on the 2019 Election, there were a total of 4,604 ballots cast in the entire election for Kane County. For the School Board, the most ballots cast was 2,362. The recall petition was circulated in the D303 community with just over 12%, a total of 299 signatures were obtained from registered voters as of April 2, 2021.

We hereby request that the Kane County Election Board review the submitted documents and make a decision on this recall.

# Reasons for Recall

## **Board Policy/Procedure**

Six board members signed the Resolution Regarding the Fall 2020 School Reopening Plan and Remote Learning Plan.

## Conflict of Interest

Five board members have conflict of interests that include being a teacher, D303 administrator, and nepotism.

## Oath Of Office

Six board board members have not kept their Oath of Office and provided an equitable and quality education for every student in the School District.

# **Board Policy/Procedure**

Six board members signed the Resolution Regarding the Fall 2020 School Reopening Plan and Remote Learning Plan (Exhibit B)

- The resolution was never discussed at a Committee meeting. According to board procedure, all items must be discussed in a Committee meeting and if supported by the board members can be moved to the Regular Board meeting agenda.
- The way the resolution appeared for a vote at the August 10, 2020 Regular Board meeting is a violation of board procedure.
- District lawyers prepared this resolution for a vote at the Regular Board meeting and were instructed to do so by either the Board Members and/or Dr. Pearson. The public never heard a discussion at a committee meeting.
- Sections 1-9 gives Dr. Pearson the power to make all decisions outlined in the resolution through June 30, 2021.
- On December 16, 2020 (Learning & Teaching Meeting), Dr. Pearson consulted with the board on the Kane County Health Department's (KCHD) recommendation for school districts to take a 2 week adaptive pause until December 4, 2020.
- The board suggested to Dr. Pearson that schools close until January 5, 2021. A SIX week closure.
- Mr. Mike Bryant and Ms. Carolyn Waibel both made strong comments leading the charge in support of the six week closure and citing possible case surge and state closure.
- Based on that board suggestion, Dr. Pearson decided to stop all in-person learning until January 5, 2020.
  - NO DATA FROM D303, IDPH, OR KANE/DUPAGE COUNTIES WAS PRESENTED AT THIS MEETING.
- Dr. Pearson stated that he was having weekly meeting with KCHD. He cited increasing cases, a possible surge, and the state closing. He did not present any data to support his claims.
- Batavia D101, Geneva D304, and Burlington D301 all reopened in-person learning on December 7, 2020. 0
- Dr. Pearson also stated that once again he would give teachers the choice to teach remotely or in-person.

# Conflict of Interest

Five board members have conflict of interests. They cannot stay objective when voting on the SCEA teacher contract and when making decisions for D303 students. All NEA-IEA union affiliates 'refuse to return to in-person learning until it is safe'.

- We have 3 board members who are teachers in other districts.
- (SCEA), Batavia D101 (BEA), and Geneva D304 (GEA) are affiliated unions with NEA-IEA the largest organization of Mr. Mike Bryant - Teacher at Batavia High School and married to a teacher in Geneva D304. St. Charles D303 teachers in Illinois.
- Academy which provides special education services to students who are outplaced by contracting public school Mrs. Jillian Barker - Teacher and currently Executive Director of Curriculum and Instruction for Parkland Prep

- The resolution was never discussed at a Committee meeting. According to board procedure, all items must be discussed in a Committee meeting and if supported by the board members can be moved to the Regular Board meeting agenda.
- The way the resolution appeared for a vote at the August 10, 2020 Regular Board meeting is a violation of board procedure.
- District lawyers prepared this resolution for a vote at the Regular Board meeting and were instructed to do so by either the Board Members and/or Dr. Pearson. The public never heard a discussion at a committee meeting.
- Sections 1-9 gives Dr. Pearson the power to make all decisions outlined in the resolution through June 30, 2021.
- On December 16, 2020 (Learning & Teaching Meeting), Dr. Pearson consulted with the board on the Kane County Health Department's (KCHD) recommendation for school districts to take a 2 week adaptive pause until December 4, 2020.
- The board suggested to Dr. Pearson that schools close until January 5, 2021. A SIX week closure.
- Mr. Mike Bryant and Ms. Carolyn Waibel both made strong comments leading the charge in support of the six week closure and citing possible case surge and state closure.
- Based on that board suggestion, Dr. Pearson decided to stop all in-person learning until January 5, 2020.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of Community Unit School District No. 303, Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois ("Board") desires to set forth its intent regarding the reopening of schools in Fall 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Illinois Governor Pritzker declared all counties in Illinois as disaster areas due to COVID-19, this declaration was subsequently extended and reissued, and a subsequent version of such declaration remains in effect for part or all of the territory of the School District as of the date of this Resolution and may be further extended or reissued (the "Disaster Proclamation"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7 of the *Illinois Emergency Management Act* (20 ILCS 3305/7) and powers granted under the Illinois Constitution and statute, the Governor ordered the closure of all public and private K-12 schools in Illinois through the end of the 2019-2020 school year and directed schools to implement remote learning; and

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order 2020-44 allowing schools to reopen for in-person educational purposes for the Fall 2020 semester in accordance with Phase 4 of the Governor's Restore Illinois plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to P.A. 101-0643, Section 10-30 of the *School Code* (105 ILCS 5/10-30) provides that, if the Governor declares a disaster due to a public health emergency, the State Superintendent of Education may declare a requirement to use remote learning days or blended remote learning days for school districts pursuant to plans adopted by individual school districts and approved, reviewed, and amended by their individual school district superintendents; and

WHEREAS, guidance and recommendations related to the reopening and operation of schools for the duration of the pandemic have been issued and will be issued by the Illinois Department of Public Health, the Illinois State Board of Education, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and other local, state, and federal agencies and entities; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois State Board of Education has provided and will continue to provide guidance to Illinois school boards and their districts on issues related to reopening schools in the Fall of 2020, including guidance emphasizing the recommencement of in-person learning for the

Fall 2020 semester, but authorizing school districts to include within their remote and blended learning plans a process for remote learning options to occur simultaneously with in-person instruction, and suggesting consideration of planning for remote instruction for certain student populations for medical reasons; and

WHEREAS the Board has adopted Policy 2:240 Board Policy Development, which authorizes the Board to adopt, revise, and temporarily suspend board policies; and

WHEREAS, the Board has adopted Policy 4:180 Pandemic Preparedness which acknowledges school closure in response to a pandemic and designates the Superintendent to act as a liaison for the School District to ensure the health and safety of students, staff, and the community; and

WHEREAS, development and implementation of plans for remote and blended learning and for the reopening of schools requires the exercise of discretion and a balancing of interests and exercise of judgment in addressing multiple goals, including reopening schools to in-person instruction so that needed services can be provided to students directly and endeavoring to protect the health of staff and students in light of COVID-19, all in the context of available resources; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 10-20, 10-20.5, and 24-24 of the School Code (105 ILCS 5/10-20, 10-20.5, and 24-24) and other applicable law, the Board has all powers requisite or proper for the maintenance, operation, and development of schools and the development of rules related thereto as contemplated by this Resolution, and whereas teachers and other employees who are licensed or provide related services to students stand in the relation of parents and guardians to the students with respect to conduct of the schools; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has presented to the Board a plan for the reopening of schools in the School District in Fall 2020 (the "Fall 2020 Reopening Plan").

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has presented to the Board a plan for Remote and/or Blended Learning (the "2020-2021 Remote Learning Plan") incorporated within the Fall 2020 Reopening Plan.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Education of Community Unit School District No. 303, Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: <u>Reopening Plan</u>. The Board has reviewed the draft Fall 2020 Reopening Plan, discussed its proposed content, and provided input.

<u>Section 2</u>: <u>Remote Learning Plan</u>. The Board has reviewed the draft 2020-2021 Remote Learning Plan, discussed its proposed content, and provided input.

<u>Section 3</u>: <u>Delegation of Authority</u>. The Board delegates to the Superintendent the discretion and authority to:

- 1. revise and finalize the foregoing Plans, considering the input provided by the Board;
- approve, implement, and interpret the foregoing Plans and determine the means and method for operating the schools and delivering instruction pursuant to such Plans and any subsequent revisions or amendments thereto, in accordance with applicable state and federal law and regulations, and in compliance with local, state, and federal guidances to the extent reasonably practicable;
- periodically review and amend the 2020-2021 Remote Learning Plan, as needed, to endeavor to meet the needs of all students in accordance with Section 10-30 of the School Code;
- 4. prepare Administrative Procedures as needed to implement such Plans, and
- 5. delegate responsibility, discretion, and authority as needed to accomplish same.

<u>Section 4</u>: <u>Modification to Policies and Procedures</u>. The Board hereby suspends any Board Policies and Administrative Procedures in conflict with the foregoing Plans and delegation of authority.

<u>Section 5</u>: <u>Enforcement</u>. The Board and Superintendent are hereby authorized to enforce compliance with the foregoing Plans and Administrative Procedures by students, staff and visitors pursuant to the general and specific provisions and processes of all applicable Board Policies, Administrative Procedures, and law.

Section 6: Closure of Buildings for Educational Purposes and to the Public. Due to the possibility of COVID-19 exposure in District facilities or resurgence of the pandemic, during the 2020-2021 school year, the Superintendent is authorized, after consultation with the Board President and notification to the Board, to suspend in-person learning and to close any school building or District facility without further action by the Board either pursuant to the Plans approved in this Resolution, the directive of the Governor or State Superintendent of Education, or the directive or recommendation of the public health authority. Such closures shall continue until such time as the Superintendent, in consultation with appropriate local, state, and federal health and government authorities, determines that it is in the best interests of the District and its students to open schools for in-person learning and/or to open school buildings or District facilities. Upon making such determination, the Superintendent shall promptly notify the Board and, as soon as practicable thereafter, shall present the District's plans for re-opening for approval by the Board at a duly noticed Board meeting (which may be either a regular meeting or a special meeting).

<u>Section 7</u>: <u>Community Use of Facilities</u>. In order to effectuate the orders of the Governor and other local, state, and federal guidance regarding social distancing, gathering, and restrictions on all but essential activities, the Board hereby delegates to the Superintendent the authority to restrict facility usage under Policy 8:20 Community Use of School Facilities, and to require third parties using school facilities to comply with applicable public health guidances. The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to allow use of District

facilities as deemed necessary or appropriate to cooperate with the Illinois Emergency Management Agency or other local, state, or federal governmental entities, community service agencies, hospitals or community support or relief efforts related to COVID-19.

<u>Section 8</u>: <u>Duration of Effect</u>. The provisions of this Resolution will apply during the period of the Disaster Proclamation currently in effect and any subsequent public health disaster declaration related to COVID-19 or related or successor virus that is effective for part or all of the School District, and for a reasonable time thereafter as may be necessary to restore normal operations following the end of the Disaster Proclamation, but in any event not later than June 30, 2021, except as that date may be extended by action of the Board.

<u>Section 9</u>: <u>Execution of this Resolution</u>. This Resolution may be signed in counterparts or on successive dates following its adoption. Any signature line in this Resolution not signed manually by the Board President or Board Secretary may be signed electronically or deemed to be signed through email or other electronic communications with the same force and effect as an original executed signed document pursuant to the Illinois *Electronic Commerce Security Act* (5 ILCS 175/1) and other applicable law.

## 2:80 Board Member Oath and Conduct

Each School Board member, before taking his or her seat on the Board, shall take the following oath of office:

I, (name), do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will faithfully discharge the duties of the office of member of the School Board of Community Unit School District 303, in accordance with the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the laws of the State of Illinois, to the best of my ability.

I further swear (or affirm) that:

I shall respect taxpayer interests by serving as a faithful protector of the School District's assets;

**I shall encourage** and respect the free expression of opinion by my fellow Board members and others who seek a hearing before the Board, while respecting the privacy of students and employees;

I shall recognize that a Board member has no legal authority as an individual and that decisions can be made only by a majority vote at a public Board meeting;

I shall abide by majority decisions of the Board, while retaining the right to seek changes in such decisions through ethical and constructive channels:

As part of the School Board, I shall accept the responsibility for my role in the equitable and quality education of every student in the School District;

I shall foster with the Board extensive participation of the community, formulate goals, define outcomes, and set the course for Community Unit School District 303;

I shall assist in establishing a structure and an environment designed to ensure all students have the opportunity to attain their maximum potential through a sound organizational framework;

I shall strive to ensure a continuous assessment of student achievement and all conditions affecting the education of our children, in compliance with State law;

I shall serve as education's key advocate on behalf of students and our community's school (or schools) to advance the vision for Community Unit School District 303; and

I shall strive to work together with the District Superintendent to lead the School District toward fulfilling the vision the Board has created, fostering excellence for every student in the areas of academic skills, knowledge, citizenship, and personal development.

The Board President will administer the oath in an open Board meeting; in the absence of the President, the Vice President will administer the oath. If neither is available, the Board member with the longest service on the Board will administer the oath.

The Board adopts the Illinois Association of School Boards' Code of Conduct for Members of School Boards. A copy of the Code shall be displayed in the regular Board meeting room.

To District 303 School Board Members,

As elected representatives for constituents, parents, students and taxpayers, we are requesting that you, the District 303 School Board, review and reform school board member policies that govern behaviors and actions of board members. A review and reform of board member policies can help strengthen the board's ability to govern, make decisions, and most importantly, have a definable consequence should a board member choose to violate their ethical requirements. Currently, board member policies are vague and lacking consequences for policy violations. For example, in March of 2019, former President Hewell was cited for an ethics violation. However, there was no public comment, no formal apology required, and no disciplinary action taken as a result of the ethics violation. (Exhibit A)

We raise this issue now as we have discovered a new possible violation by a current board member. As you will see in Exhibit B, Board Member McCabe engaged in a course of behavior that questions her involvement in the hiring of a St. Charles employee. At a very minimum, Board Member McCabe's actions in participating in the voting of the employee, as demonstrated in the exhibit, shows that she had the appearance of a conflict of interest. We have engaged outside legal counsel to review this behavior and she is of the opinion that it was a conflict of interest for Board Member McCabe to cast her vote. The ultimate issue before you is what consequence Board Member McCabe would suffer if found to be in violation. It is the opinion of our outside counsel that the Board Policies do not have a real consequence to violations such as this.

There are several policies that have not been reviewed by this Board. The time and need to update these policies and make the necessary changes to ensure professional and ethical behavior is now. We are recommending appointing an outside ethics advisor (someone other than Hodges, Lozzi, Eisenhammer, Rodick & Kohn LLP) who can provide necessary guidance to the board regarding these long overdue changes.

In review of current board policies, we highlighted the following policies as examples of opportunity for reform.

- 1. Policy 2:140 Communication To and From the Board
  - a. Board members should not meet individually with superintendent, administrators, or program directors to discuss or plan new/future agenda items (construction, curriculum, resources, programs) that will be presented at committee meetings to all board members for the first time.
- 2. Policy 2:100 Conflict of Interest
  - a. Economic Interest Statements were not submitted by 3 of the 7 board members in May 2019, specifically Jillian Barker, Becky McCabe, and Mike Bryant. (5ILcs420/4A-107). (Exhibit C)
  - Anti-Nepotism. No one in the immediate family of any board member will be employed in any continuing capacity by the school system. Indian Prairie D204 Policy 2:90. (Exhibit D)
- 3. Policy 2:105 Ethics and Gift Ban
  - No consequences for actions of former board president Mrs. Hewell for ethics violation 3/11/19.
- 4. Policy 2:60 Board Member Removal From Office
  - a. A limited policy that needs more substance, guidelines, and consequences.
- 5. Policy 2:50 Board Member Term of Office
  - a. Term limits for the number of consecutive terms a board member can serve.

- 6. Policy 2:110 Qualifications, Term, Duties of Board Officers
  - Perform all duties as outlined for voted board positions such as President, VP, and Secretary.

The board will meet April 20, 2020 to discuss and update policies. We ask that the policies mentioned above are added to the meeting agenda for discussion and a reform completed before August 12, 2020.

We believe the elected members of our D303 School Board should have effective policies and an evaluation process in place to monitor behavior and actions of all board members. It is also important that Board Members have a punishment for their violations of our trust and the ethics guidelines. Policy reform will establish a transparent process which is the foundation for building trust between elected officials and their constituents. Let's bring back confidence in those who are elected into office.

On January 20, 2019 and January 22, 2019, Dr. Jason Pearson received two complaints, one from Ms. Danielle Penman and the other from Ms. Michelle Casile. Ms. Penman and Ms. Casile contacted Dr. Pearson claiming that several school board members violated Board Policy 2:105 (Ethics and Gift Ban). Pursuant to Board Policy 2:105, Dr. Pearson appointed me as the Ethics Advisor to investigate these two complaints. This report sets forth the relevant legal background and policy provisions, summarizes my investigation and findings, and provides a recommendation to address those findings.

In short, one Board member unintentionally committed a minor violation of the Act. As a remedy, I recommend that the Board member as well as all Board members review this report, along with the relevant Board Policies and laws, to ensure that such violations do not occur in the future. This remedy is consistent with the prior remedies imposed for similar violations of this Board Policy.

## I. Background

Prior to the April 2, 2019, Illinois Consolidated Election, which encompasses statewide school board elections, Ms. Penman filed objections to the candidacy of current Board President Kathleen Hewell and current Board Vice-President Nick Manheim with the Kane County Clerk, alleging that both candidates wrongfully obtained signatures on their Petitions for Nomination in violation of the District's Board policies.

On January 4, 2019, the Kane County Officers Electoral Board ("Electoral Board") held hearings regarding Ms. Penman's objections in two separate cases, including: (1) Case 04-02-EB-56 – addressing Ms. Penman's objection to the candidacy of Board President Hewell; and (2) Case 04-02-EB-57 – addressing Ms. Penman's objection to the candidacy of Board Vice-President Manheim.

Ms. Penman appeared and presented testimony in both hearings. To support her testimony, she also submitted exhibits, including the Petition for Nomination signature sheets for both Board President Hewell and Board Vice-President Manheim. At the conclusion of each hearing, the Electoral Board announced that it would reconvene on January 8, 2019, to issue its decision.

On January 8, 2019, the Electoral Board issued its decisions, dismissing Ms. Penman's objections to the candidacy of both Board President Hewell and Board Vice-President Manheim. The Electoral Board reasoned that it has limited-authority jurisdiction, and thereby cannot delve into matters outside of the *Election Code* and into questions that may arise under the District's Board policies.

Shortly thereafter, on January 20 and January 22, 2019, Dr. Pearson received letters from Ms. Penman and Ms. Casile alleging that multiple school board members violated Board Policy 2:105. The alleged violations are best summarized in Ms. Penman's complaint as:

- "Board President Kathleen Hewell, who is seeking re-election, got fellow board members Lori Linkimer, Heidi Fairgrieve, Ed McNally, Scott Nowling and Nick Manheim to sign a petition sheet for her at a board meeting on district property."
- "Kathleen Hewell also circulated a petition sheet for the Vice-President, Nick Manheim, who is also seeking re-election to the Board."

In their letters, Ms. Penman and Ms. Casile requested that Dr. Pearson appoint an ethics advisor from outside the District to investigate the allegations. Accordingly, Dr. Pearson processed Dr. Penman's letter as a complaint under Board Policy 2:105 and appointed me as the Ethics Advisor to investigate Dr. Penman's complaint, leading to this report and recommendation.

## II. Ethics Act

In 2003, the legislature enacted the State Officials and Employees Ethics Act (the "Ethics Act"), 5 ILCS 430/1-1 et seq., which more comprehensively regulates the use of compensated time and public resources for prohibited political activities (as well as the soliciting and accepting of gifts) by State employees and officials. The Ethics Act further requires all local governmental entities, including school districts, to adopt an ordinance (i.e., Board policy) regulating the political activities of their officers and employees "in a manner no less restrictive than [certain provisions] of the Act." The law also directed the Attorney General to develop a model resolution and advise local governments on the Act. The Board fulfilled its obligation under the Ethics Act by adopting your Board Policy 2:105 (Ethics and Gift Ban). This report focuses on the political activities portion of the Ethics Act, as there are no issues here involving the solicitation or acceptance of gifts.

Board Policy 2:105 more or less mirrors the restrictions of the Ethics Act and sets forth the following precepts:

No employee shall intentionally perform any "prohibited political activity" during any
compensated time. No Board member or employee shall intentionally use any property or
resources of the School District in connection with any prohibited political activity. (Emphasis
Added.)

- 2. At no time shall any Board member or employee intentionally require any other Board member or employee to perform any prohibited political activity as part of that Board member's or employee's duties, as a condition of employment, or during any compensated time off (such as holidays, vacation, or personal leave).
- 3. No Board member or employee shall be required at any time to participate in any prohibited political activity in consideration for that Board member or employee being awarded additional compensation or any benefit, whether in the form of a salary adjustment, bonus, compensatory time off, continued employment or otherwise, nor shall any [sic] or employee be awarded additional compensation or any benefit in consideration for his or her participation in any prohibited political activity.

Board Policy 2:105 and the Ethics Act contain a specific list of 15 "prohibited political activities" in which officers and employees may not engage under the above circumstances. The provisions that apply here are the following:

- Initiating for circulation, preparing, circulating, reviewing, or filing any petition on behalf
  of a candidate for elective office of for or against any referendum question.
- Campaigning for any elective office or for or against any referendum question.

Under Board Policy and the Ethics Act, interpretive confusion exists over the use of compensated time to engage in prohibited political activities. Board Policy 2:105 and the Ethics Act define "compensated time" as:

Compensated time means any time worked by or credited to an employee that counts toward any minimum work time requirement imposed as a condition of his or her employment, but for purposes of this Policy, does not include any designated holidays, vacation periods, personal time, compensatory time off, or any period when the employee is on leave of absence. With respect to employees or officers whose hours are not fixed, compensated time includes any period of time when the officer or employee is executing his or her official duties, regardless of location.

Yet, the Board Policy prohibits only employees from performing prohibited political activities during compensated time. However, it is my opinion that Board members are prohibited from engaging in prohibited political activities during any time spent performing official duties whether on or off school property. Nevertheless, it is important to note that the Illinois Association of School Boards takes the position that "compensated time" does not apply to Board members, while the Illinois Attorney General takes the position that "compensated time" includes any time spent performing official duties and any time on the property of the entity that the Board members are elected to serve. In any event, the resolution of this issue is not necessary in this case because the activities in this case did not occur during "compensated time" under any definition.

As referenced above, Board Policy 2:105 also states, "No Board member or employee shall intentionally use any property or resources of the School District in connection with any prohibited political activity." Unlike "compensated time," the Ethics Act does not define "use of school district property or resources."

Accordingly, it is my opinion Board members may not engage in prohibited political activities on District property.

Board Policy 2:105 contains the following provisions concerning its enforcement:

### Inquiries, Complaints, and Penalties

- An Ethics Advisor may be appointed by the Superintendent to provide guidance to the school board, its officers, and its employees concerning the interpretation of and compliance with the provisions of this Policy and the State Officials and Employees Ethics Act.
- 2. Ethics Advisor shall have the following powers and duties:
  - · Adopt procedures for managing the complaint.
  - · Receive information about the complaint.
  - · Investigate the complaint.
  - Request the aid of an attorney.
  - Recommend any actions related to the investigation.
- 3. Anyone who believes that an individual covered by the Policy has violated its prohibitions may submit a written report detailing the incident to the Superintendent who will forward the complaint to the appointed Ethics Advisor. If the Superintendent is the subject of the complaint, the written report detailing the incident should be submitted to the president of the Board of Education. The Board shall review the appointment of the Ethics Advisor as needed.
- 4. Upon receipt of a complaint, the appointed Ethics Advisor will investigate the matter and issue a report and recommendation to the Board. For complaints involving conduct of employees, the Superintendent shall include recommendations as to any employee discipline or discharge.

### III. Investigation Summary

My investigation into this matter included first reviewing the complainants' letters to Dr. Pearson. I reviewed the transcripts of the hearings held before the Kane County Officers Election Board, including (1) Case 04-02-EB-56 (addressing Ms. Penman's objection to the candidacy of Board President Hewell); and (2) Case 04-02-EB-57 (addressing Ms. Penman's objection to the candidacy

of Board Vice-President Manheim). Along with the hearing transcripts, I reviewed all relevant exhibits, including the Petition for Nomination signature sheets for both Board President Hewell and Board Vice-President Manheim.

Most importantly, I interviewed Ms. Penman, Ms. Casile, Board President Hewell, and Board Vice-President Manheim. Although neither Ms. Penman nor Ms. Casile saw Board members sign President Hewell's petition on school property, both President Hewell and Board Vice-President Manheim admitted that President Hewell circulated the petition after a Board meeting while still on District property. Mr. Manheim stated he voluntarily signed the petition and was not coerced in any way or promised any benefit if he signed the petition. There was no evidence that any other Board member was coerced into signing or promised any benefit.

Lastly, I reviewed all relevant laws and policies, including the Election Code, the State Officials and Employees Ethics Act, the Illinois Local Governmental Employees Political Rights Act, and Board Policy 2:105.

### IV. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

- After the conclusion of a Board meeting, but while still on the premises of the District's Administration Center, Board President Hewell circulated her Petition for Nomination to obtain signatures from her fellow Board members. Thereafter, five Board members – Heidi Fairgrieve, Lori Linkimer, Nick Manheim, Ed McNally, and Scott Nowling – signed her petition, all while still on the premises of the District's Administration Center.
- 2. The signing of the petition by Heidi Fairgrieve, Kathleen Hewell, Lori Linkimer, Nick Manheim, Ed McNally, and Scott Nowling did not constitute prohibited political activities under Board Policy 2:105 and the Ethics Act because they did not initiate, circulate, prepare, review, or file any petition on behalf of a candidate for elective office. Nor does signing the petition constitute campaigning for any elective office. To constitute campaigning for elective office, the activity must be "in furtherance of an effort to influence... the nomination..." Signing a nominating petition is not an activity in furtherance of an effort to influence a nomination.
- President Hewell's circulation of her own nominating petition constituted a Prohibited Political Activity. Although it did not occur during "compensated time" (the Board meeting had ended), it did occur on school property. Therefore, this activity violated Board Policy.
- 4. The Policy's prohibition against a Board member circulating a nominating petition on school property may be unconstitutional as it violates both the First Amendment's Free Speech Clause and the Fourteenth Amendment's Equal Protection Clause. The Policy does not prohibit non-Board member candidates from circulating petitions on school

property (at least on school property open to the public) and there is neither a rational or compelling reason for making a distinction between Board member candidates and non-Board member candidates. If there is one, the prohibition is both overbroad and not the least restrictive means to accomplish the intended purpose.

- 5. In any event the violation was a minor unintentional violation under Board Policy 2:105. There is no evidence of undue influence by Board President Hewell to obtain signatures. Nor did Hewell make a promise of any benefit. Rather, each Board members' decision to sign her Petition for Nomination was voluntary. Moreover, the decision to collect signatures at the conclusion of the Board meeting was purely out of convenience, in that a majority of Board members were all in the same location due to the earlier Board meeting. The Board members could have easily walked out of the building, stood on the sidewalk in front of the building, and signed the petition. In that case, there would have been no violation of the Policy.
- Board President Hewell also circulated Board Vice-President Nick Manheim's Petition for Nomination to obtain signatures on his behalf to her neighbors on Wing Lane in St. Charles.
- The above action of Board President Hewell does not violate the Board Policy because it did not occur during compensated time or on District property.

### IV. Recommendation

I recommend that President Hewell and all of the other Board members be required to review Board Policy 2:105. The Policy, which is based on the law, is complex and can be confusing to a lay person. I would also recommend that a Board in-service be held every two years to ensure violations do not occur. I do not recommend any additional "punishment" for the reasons stated in paragraphs 4 and 5 of my Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law. The one violation in this case did not result in the Board member gaining any advantage and was unintentional. Finally, I note my recommendations are consistent with recommendations I made when an employee unintentionally violated this Board Policy. In that case the employee distributed campaign material using the District's email system where the employee could have easily used his/her personal email addresses which the employee had done in the past.

The Public Access Bureau has received the attached Request for Review in which Ms. Michelle Casile alleges that the St. Charles Community Unit School District 303
Board of Education (Board) violated the Open Meetings Act (OMA). Specifically, Ms. Casile alleges that the Board held an in-person meeting on January 11, 2021, in which ten members of the public were allowed to attend due to COVID-19 restrictions, but that the Board did not allow public comment at the meeting by remote means. We construe the Request for Review as alleging a violation of section 2.06(g) of OMA (5 ILCS 120/2.06(g) (West 2018)). We have determined that further action is warranted.

In order to further evaluate this matter, please provide a detailed written response to the allegations raised by Ms. Casile's Request for Review. In your response, please clarify the manner in which members of the public who were not at the January 11, 2021, meeting in person

Section 2.06(g) of OMA requires any person to be "permitted an opportunity to address public officials under the rules established and recorded by the public body."

This information must be submitted to our office within seven (7) business days after receipt of this letter. 5 ILCS 120/3.5(b) (West 2018). As we review this matter, we will notify you if we require additional records or information. Please note that under OMA, "[t]he Public Access Counselor shall forward a copy of the answer or redacted answer, if furnished, to the person submitting the request for review. The requester may, but is not required to, respond in writing[.]" 5 ILCS 120/3.5(c) (West 2018). If you claim that any portion of your written response is confidential, please send two versions of your response letter: a complete copy for this office's confidential review and a redacted version suitable for this office to forward to the requester.

#### Dear Public Access,

Since March 2020 St. Charles School D303 has changed their meeting public comment procedure from a call in number to in-person comments only. This change in public comment format (from a call in number to in-person comments only) changes with the student instructional modality of remote or in-person. There is very little to no communication sent directly to the public to alert them of the changes in meeting public comment format. This has led to confusion and fear of restricting first amendment rights. D303 does not have one standard meeting procedure with multiple avenues of communication for public comments during Covid-19. D303 link to Boardbook.: <a href="https://meetings.boardbook.org/Public/Organization/1802">https://meetings.boardbook.org/Public/Organization/1802</a>.

Most recently, on January 11 there was a Regular Board meeting and public comments were only allowed inperson. There was no formal communication sent out to the public in advance regarding the change in meeting format or in-person only public comments. Public should have been notified of the change when the agenda came out January 7, 2021.

Many parents were prepared to leave a message for the meeting on the call in number. There was a great deal of confusion among parents that day. There was also a very hot topic for vote on the agenda that evening. Many people wanted to leave a comment regarding this topic and could not attend the meeting in-person. D303 provided the board email which is the general board email that per board policy 2:140 only administration responds to. This is not an email specifically for public comments at a meeting. Any comments sent to this general email were not read at the January 11, 2021 board meeting. Enclosed are screenshots of boardbook meeting notifications found only on the D303 website.

I feel that D303 should provide alternate avenues for public comments regardless of students being all remote or in-person (hybrid). There should be multiple pathways for public comment for individuals who cannot go to the meeting because of health concerns. I feel that the right to make a public comment was and is being restricted by D303 because they do not have a standard meeting procedure for meeting public comments during Covid-19.
